The RSVP Campaign in Missouri

The Restoring Social Virtue and Purity to America (RSVP) Campaign is designed to equip parents with vital information on Dr. Alfred Kinsey's fraudulently-based revolution of the 1960s and to show them how the Kinseyan sexual revolution is alive and well today in our children's school rooms.

It's imperative that parents understand how America went from chastity and morality to Kinsey and "anything goes" in just one generation. Is there any hope? Eventually, as people believed Kinsey's lies, America's tough laws concerning crimes and punishments of sex offenders were weakened and some of them overthrown in favor of weaker crimes and punishments.

For example, rape used to bring the death penalty in three states and life imprisonment in at least 18 others. We know now that many rapists just get a "slap on the hand" or are soon released to commit the same acts again. Sending pornography through the mail used to be illegal, as well as abortion and homosexuality. Now, the only law left intact is concerning the crime of pedophilia, and that will soon be legal if we don't do something to stop it.
